

ROTARACT CLUB OF COBDEN

The Rotaract Club of Cobden Received its charter on Saturday, September 13, 1975 when inaugural president Brian Healy accepted the charter from Rotary District Governor Murray Mitchell.

Cobden Rotaractors enjoyed themselves but in an era of members moving to study, establishing careers and competing with many other rural groups it struggled to maintain sufficient membership and folded in 1982. In that time many locals took on leadership roles of the club.

Rotaract and Rotary held four combined changeover dinners during their existence in an effort to galvanise the two clubs. A weekly roster existed in the early years for Rotarians to attend the Rotaract meetings and offer advice when requested and report back to the club.
